On December 30, 2020 the State Committee of Information Technology and Communications of the Kyrgyz Republic puts into circulation a Kyrgyz Express Post postage stamp: "Stop COVID-19!"

The pandemic has been a huge challenge for the world's health services, which are facing the need to provide emergency care to millions of people.
